Essential Job Functions:

1. Performing audiologic evaluations on infants through adults. Testing to include speech audiometry, pure tone air and bone conduction, tympanograms, acoustic reflexes, acoustic reflex decay.
2. Performing Otoacoustic Emissions.
3. Performing Auditory Brainstem Response testing.
4. Obtaining complete medical history and writing reports.
5. Counsel patients regarding test results.
6. Selection and fitting of hearing aids with verification of fitting using visible speech mapping.
7. Articulate the Pee Dee Speech & Hearing Center's mission, values and policies to staff and clients; demonstrate commitment to mission, values and policies in the performance of daily duties.

- Must hold a certificate of Clinical Competence in Audiology from ASHA or be eligible for certification.
- Eligible for South Carolina state licensure in Audiology
