PRACTICE:

Dr. Aaron Liebman started in private practice in 1982 in Albany, NY. In 2001, he opened Aaron's Hearing Aid & Audiology Center, the only Audiologist owned hearing care office in Indian River County. A second office, in Port St. Lucie, was opened in 2005 and is the only audiologist owned office in Port St. Lucie. Both offices have provided services to numerous patients successfully. The patients have grown to appreciate the care and concern they receive and understand that their best interest is in mind to help improve and optimize their hearing.

POSITION:

The audiologist is responsible for performing proper diagnostic testing as well as hearing aid evaluations, selection and fitting of hearing aids in a physician setting. The audiologist will be responsible for counseling patients regarding their test results, reviewing options which best meet their hearing care needs, assist the patient concerning technology options relative to their lifestyle, and review fees relative to their level of investment ability. The audiologist must feel comfortable by having the patient select hearing aids and setting an appointment for dispensing the hearing aids. The audiologist will follow corporate guidelines for processing paperwork necessary for tracking hearing aids that are ordered, dispensed, sent for repair or returned for credit.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Provide audiology services as described above and follow any established protocols.
- Interpret, review, report on and counsel patients regarding test results.
- Complete chart notes for each patient and send a written report to the referring physician and primary care physician.
- Consult with and makes recommendations to physicians concerning hearing disorders.
- Coordinate care with physicians and other providers.
- Review and make recommendations regarding hearing care options and products such as assistive listening devices (ALD's) available to improve hearing ability.
- Dispense appropriate hearing care products to meet the needs of the patient.
- Provides follow-up care and education.
- Perform hearing aid checks, cleanings and appropriate modifications and repairs.
- Tracks patient appointments, hearing aids ordered, dispensed, sent for repair or returned for credit.

JOB SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

- Au.D. degree with current Florida state licensure in Audiology or the ability to acquire state licensure expeditiously.
- Excellent interpersonal skills that allow effective working relationships with a diverse patient, colleague, and vendor population. Listening skills, professional sales ability, problem solving skills and care and respect for patients is of utmost importance.
- Strong computer, hearing aid software and equipment experience.
- Must be detailed oriented, able to organize time, prioritize numerous duties within strict deadlines and work with numerous interruptions.
