

AUDIOLOGY POSITION IN A BUSY ENT/HEARING AID DISPENSING PRACTICE

Bellingham Ear, Nose and Throat/Hearing Health Clinic, located in beautiful Bellingham, Washington (approximately 1 1/2 hours north of Seattle and 1/2 hour south of the Canadian Border), is the only otolaryngology office in Whatcom County. Additionally, our Hearing Health Clinic is the only physician directed audiology office in Whatcom County. We work closely with our five otolaryngologists (one specializing in otology) and employ three audiologists (two full time/one part time). Our Hearing Health Clinic has a receptionist trained to perform simple audiology assistant tasks.

Responsibilities:

Although we are looking for a full-time audiologist, the position can be somewhat flexible for the right candidate. Candidate would perform basic diagnostic testing, as well as hearing aid selection, fitting, follow up and counseling. Extensive hearing aid experience is not required.

Education and Experience Requirements:

Masters or Au.D. with a current Washington State Audiology/Dispensing license. Fourth year audiology students and recent audiology graduates are also encouraged to apply.
