TITLE/RANK: Assistant Professor

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Responsibilities include teaching graduate and undergraduate courses, directing student research, advising graduate students, and may include supervising clinical experiences. Teaching responsibilities may include evening offerings. Opportunities exist for administrative responsibilities. Successful applicants will have experience in any of the following areas: voice disorders, dysphagia, and motor speech disorders. Additional responsibilities related to tenure and promotion include professional development, university and professional service, and a continued record of scholarly activity. The Department seeks faculty who are committed to working in a culturally diverse community.
