Radford University (RU) invites applications and nominations for the position of Chair in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders. This is a nine-month, tenure/tenure-track position with a summer stipend at the rank of associate/full professor. Required qualifications include an earned doctoral degree in speech-language pathology or related field, eligibility for Virginia licensure in Speech-Language Pathology, and CCC-SLP. Preferred qualifications include experience as an administrator and scholar, ability to provide research mentoring for faculty, and expertise in adult disorders. Responsibilities include departmental administration, evaluation of faculty and staff, teaching graduate and undergraduate coursework, clinical supervision, advising students, mentoring faculty members in scholarship and teaching, and service to the university and community.

Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications and experience. All candidates must submit a letter of application, a current curriculum vita, and names, addresses and phone numbers of three references. The successful candidate will also be required to provide official transcripts. Consideration of applicants will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled. Start date is negotiable.
