- The Pediatric Rehabilitation Program at Cardon Children's Medical Center provides therapy for children and adolescents ages 0 to 18 yrs. of age.
- The Rehabilitation Program consists of Speech-Language Pathology for both Inpatient and Outpatient programs as well as Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy.
- The Speech-Language Pathology Team consists of comprehensive services to include articulation, language, fluency, cognitive re-training, voice, cochlear implant, feeding/swallowing.
- The Speech-Language Pathology Team provides specialized services including FEES, MBS, Video-stroboscopy, Newborn Follow-up Program, Feeding Program
- The Pediatric Rehabilitation Program promotes interdisciplinary collaboration between all disciplines and medical professionals to include Patient Care meetings, co-treating, Nursing Unit Rounds
- Therapy goals are Family Centered and designed to increase functional independence at home, school, and community settings.
