

The Raymond G. Murphy VA Medical Center in Albuquerque, New Mexico is seeking candidates for a Clinical Fellowship position. Although the position is set to begin early October 2011, we are able to consider accommodations beginning in August if desired by the applicant.

The Speech Pathology department provides both inpatient and outpatient services. The placement would include (1) more traditional speech pathology coupled with participation in the Z-ACT (Zia Assistive Computerized Technology) Speech Pathology Program through our Spinal Cord Injury unit and (2) typical medical speech pathology focusing on either voice and laryngectomy rehabilitation through our ENT clinic or an emphasis on the neurological population depending on the CFY's interest. The CFY will gain experience in the use of assistive technology, perform fluoroscopic and endoscopic swallow evaluations, and endoscopic voice evaluations.
