

The University of Kentucky, Clinical Voice Center, Division of Communication Sciences and Disorders, College of Health Sciences is seeking a motivated Speech-Language Pathology graduate to fill a 12-month clinical fellowship position dedicated to the evaluation and treatment of voice and swallowing disorders. The UK Voice Clinic provides diagnostic and treatment services for a wide range of voice / swallowing disorders in an outpatient Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Clinic setup.

This is an exciting opportunity for the candidate to gain training and experience in diagnostic techniques including stroboscopy, high speed imaging, flexible endoscopic examination of swallow, modified barium swallow study, endoscopic examination of velopharyngeal port, acoustics, aerodynamics, perceptual voice assessments, and voice therapy. Responsibilities will include comprehensive assessment and treatment of voice disorders in adults and children and providing counseling and education to patients and other health care providers. Candidates must be eligible for temporary Kentucky licensure and ASHA certification.
