

Full Time Faculty Position in Audiology
A.T. Still University -Arizona School of Health Sciences

Position: The Audiology Department of A.T. Still University (ATSU) - Arizona School of Health Sciences (ASHS) is seeking to fill one full-time, 12 month (1.0 FTE) faculty position with faculty rank and competitive salary commensurate with qualifications. This faculty position also involves clinical coordination for doctor of audiology students.

Qualifications: Qualified candidates must possess a doctoral degree (Ph.D., Au.D., or equivalent) and prior university teaching experience. Preferred areas of teaching expertise include pediatric audiology, cochlear implants and/or auditory processing disorders. Candidates must also be licensed or eligible for audiology licensure in Arizona. Prior experiences in clinical practice, serving as a preceptor for audiology students and/or involvement in clinical placement of students are also advantageous for this position.

Primary Responsibilities: Development and teaching of doctoral level courses in audiology in the candidate's areas of specialty, working with the audiology faculty to evaluate the content and sequencing of courses, and serving as one of two audiology clinical coordinators which involves developing, evaluating and coordinating local clinical placements for students and overseeing management of clinical data with the assistance of one part-time clerical staff member. All audiology faculty at the Arizona School of Health Sciences also contribute to implementation of the departments strategic plan, recruitment and advising of audiology students, and the interdisciplinary teaching and interaction between the various programs on the ATSU Mesa campus. A portion of the faculty member's time will be available for service and scholarly activities. Independent practice in audiology by faculty is also viewed as favorable.

About ATSU and ASHS: ATSU is committed to educating and preparing its students to practice at the forefront of today's dynamic healthcare system, focusing on the full scope of practice of audiology and a team approach to healthcare. ATSU includes the founding school of osteopathic medicine--Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine (KCOM), the School of Health Management (SHM), the Arizona School of Health Sciences (ASHS), the Arizona School of Dentistry and Oral Health (ASDOH), and the School of Osteopathic Medicine in Arizona (SOMA). ASHS offers master of science degrees in occupational therapy, physician assistant studies, athletic training, and human movement and doctoral degrees in audiology (Au.D.), physical therapy (D.P.T), and health science (D.H.Sc.). The university matriculates approximately 600 new students each year with over 1,000 students on the Mesa campus annually, including an average of 12 students per year in the residential Au.D. Program. ATSU also has approximately 2000 online students enrolled in various programs with approximately 250 online students enrolled in the transitional Au.D. Program.

ATSU-ASHS is located in Mesa, Arizona where the sun shines over 300 days a year. You will find a vibrant and dynamic urban lifestyle in the Valley of the Sun. The area offers major league football, baseball, hockey, and basketball, three national parks, 25 state parks, numerous golf courses and 100 miles of trails for hiking, biking, and horseback riding. The symphony, opera, art festivals, museums, and restaurants provide a diverse night life.
