



The University of South Florida (USF) Doctor of Audiology Program is seeking a 12-month Clinical Instructor/Supervisor in Audiology. This position requires supervision of Au.D. students in the USF Hearing Clinic and in externship settings as well as providing direct clinical services, coordinating externship assignments and associated documentation, and teaching in all areas of audiology at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The candidate will be expected to provide a presentation to the faculty and students on a topic to be announced. Minority applicants are encouraged to apply. The position will begin in August, 2012.

Minimum Qualifications: Au.D. or Ph.D. in Audiology, eligibility for clinical certification in Audiology (CCC-A), eligibility for Florida state licensure in Audiology, a minimum of 3 years of clinical practice in audiology, experience in university teaching, and experience in clinical supervision. Preferred Qualifications: A minimum of 4 years of experience in university teaching, a minimum of 4 years of experience in clinical supervision, a minimum of 5 years of clinical practice in audiology, experience coordinating externship assignments and associated documentation for Au.D. students.
